

Immunisation Catch-Up Template

For children currently aged from 10 years up to 11 years (<11 years)
with ***NO*** documented history of vaccination

Important information *This catch-up template covers funded vaccines only.*

- This funded 'expanded catch-up program' for ≥ 10 years will **not** include dTpa-IPV, MMRV or ADT vaccines.
- Sources for checking vaccination records: AIR records; VIVAS records; Personal Health Record Book; patient records; previous service provider – please ensure you access all available information **prior to vaccinating the patient.**

Do not use:

- Infanrix-Hexa; Infanrix-IPV, Infanrix/Tripacel and Menitorix vaccines are not registered for people aged ≥ 10 years.
- Priorix-Tetra and ProQuad (combination MMRV vaccines) are **no longer funded** for ≥ 10 years.
- Use MMR (Priorix or MMR-II and Varicella (Varivax or Varilrix) vaccines as indicated in table below.

Refer to the electronic version of the Australian Immunisation Handbook (AIH) further details

Note: If these vaccines are started at different times, ensure the minimum spacing between vaccines containing the same antigen/s is adhered to.
