# **Immunisation Catch-Up Template**

# For children currently aged from 10 years up to 11 years (<11 years) with <u>NO</u> documented history of vaccination

## Important information This catch-up template covers funded vaccines only.

- This funded **'expanded catch-up program'** for <a>210</a> years will <u>not</u> include dTpa-IPV, MMRV or ADT vaccines.
- Sources for checking vaccination records: AIR records; VIVAS records; Personal Health Record Book; patient records; previous service provider – please ensure you access all available information prior to vaccinating the patient.

#### Do not use:

- Infanrix-Hexa; Infanrix-IPV, Infanrix/Tripacel and Menitorix vaccines are not registered for people aged <u>></u>10 years.
- Priorix-Tetra and ProQuad (combination MMRV vaccines) are no longer funded for >10 years.
- Use MMR (Priorix or MMR-II and Varicella (Varivax or Varilrix) vaccines as indicated in table below.

**Note:** If these vaccines are started at different times, ensure the minimum spacing between vaccines containing the same antigen/s is adhered to.

one month later give:	IPOL [inactivated polio vaccine]	Dose 3
Then,	HB VAX-II or Engerix B [paed] [hepatitis B vaccine - paediatric]	Dose 3
two months later give:	[give at least 3 months after dose 2 of hepatitis B vaccine]	

### AIR
