### How does my general practice use my information?



Your general practice records and securely stores information about your health.

This general practice may use this information to take part in quality improvement and research to improve the quality of care provided to you and your family.

### What happens to my information

- Be assured, the information collected, used and stored for these purposes remains anonymous to comply with the Australian Privacy Principles contained in the Privacy Act 1998
- In the unlikely event of a breach of your data, your GP is obligated to notify you as soon as possible
- If you would like more information, speak to your the practice manager

### Can I opt out?

- Yes. Talk to the practice manager
- Once you opt out, your information will not be used for quality improvement or research purposes
