Training includes online modules, videos, case discussions, and group work. Eligible attendees can apply for state authorisation to prescribe HIV s100 medication.

Target Audience

This course is in high demand and priority will be given to General Practitioners and Nurse Practitioners who work in community settings in QLD.

Course Components

Facilitated online training: This four-week facilitated course is comprised of online-self paced activities and weekly interactive case study webinars.

Weekly activities will take approximately 1-2 hours per week and must be completed prior to attending the case-study webinar. Each week will focus on a specific topic: Initiation of ART, Monitoring ART, Toxicities and Adverse Effects, and Special Scenarios.

Post course assessment: An online case-based multiple-choice exam to be completed within one month of the facilitated training.
