WHAT WE OFFER

Primary and preventative health care from a nurse and GP, including:

-  General health checks and assessments
-  Wound care, skin checks and dressings
-  Basic medications and medication support
-  Mental health support and brief interventions
-  Referrals and, where possible, care coordination with local services

Please note: Controlled medications, including Schedule 8 medicines, are not provided on site. If needed, we can support prescriptions and connect people with available services.

HOW YOUR ORGANISATION CAN USE THIS SERVICE

- Encourage people to visit during the daily drop in time
- Let us know where people are gathering so we can plan outreach
- Coordinate a joint visit with your outreach team
