Country to Coast, QLD Board announces new CCQ Clinical Advisory Council







Country to Coast, QLD (CCQ) is an independent, not-for-profit organisation that delivers the Primary Health Network (PHN) programs on behalf of the Commonwealth Department of Health and Aged Care. Through community needs-assessment we aim to commission leading health services which meet the needs of our region to achieve their healthiest outcomes.

During June the Country to Coast, QLD (CCQ) Board engaged with eligible healthcare professionals from across the Central Queensland, Wide Bay and Sunshine Coast regions, to consolidate the existing three clinical councils into one council which would advise collectively on achieving health outcomes region wide, the Country to Coast, QLD (CCQ) Clinical Council. This enhanced council will not only help CCQ to understand local nuances of smaller communities but also enable us to collectively work on issues which are common everywhere.

CCQ Board Chair, Dr Peter Dobson is proud to announce the 17 health professionals who will make up the new Clinical Council, providing advice directly to the CCQ Board and Executive. Their opportunity is to bring localised strategic insight to help shape the future of primary care across the region.
