Mental Health Referral pathways reference guide

This guide provides a brief summary of the health pathways for the mental health services. For the most up-to-date information on assessment, management and requests, it is recommended that GPs visit the Sunshine Coast Community <u>Health Pathways</u> (username: usersc password: pwsc).

PHN funded Mental Health Services - Stepped Care

The PHN has commissioned mental health services using a Stepped Care framework. Table below shows streams and referral criteria.

Low intensity - >= 16; At risk or mild symptoms

Child and youth - 12-25 year; Mild, moderate and severe

Psychological therapies -Moderate to severe; Hard to reach/underserviced

Complex care coordination - Severe, complex and at risk of hospitalisation

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander - At risk or have mild, moderate, or severe

Suicide prevention after-care - Postsuicide attempt
